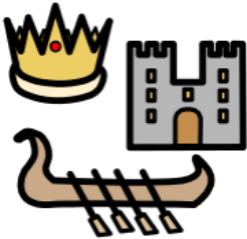


Year 1 Homework Grid – Autumn Term 1

During the course of this half term, please complete the tasks on the grid below and record your learning in your homework book. Please bring in all the activities you have completed on Wednesday 14th October to show and share your home learning with your class teacher and peers. Your child will have the opportunity to talk about their learning and they will receive stickers or house points for each completed piece of homework.

You can choose the order you complete the tasks in and how you show your learning. We recommend perhaps doing one task each week, little and often. All of the tasks set are linked to learning in class.

Subject	Learning Task		Completed
Maths		With an adult, stand outside your home and for 5 minutes, tally the number of vehicles that go past. Record how many cars, lorries, buses, vans and bikes you see.	
Writing		Write a postcard or letter to a family member or friend telling them all of the wonderful things about living in Amersham.	
Reading		Visit your local Library and read/listen to a book with your grown up. What did you like about the story? Why? Who were your favourite characters? Why? Would you recommend the book to a friend? Why?	
Art		Choose your favourite place in the local area and draw or paint a picture of it.	
Geography		Create a map of the road you live on, the local park or the high street in Amersham. Create your own symbols and add a key to show features such as; houses, shops and trees.

History	 Research some facts about the history of Amersham. Write or draw 5 facts you have learnt.
